

## Emeritus Fellow

### General Description

Physicians or related scientists who (1) have been Fellows in the Society for at least ten years; (2) previously actively participated in the mission of the Society either as an officer, Committee member, or have regularly contributed to postgraduate courses; and (3) made substantial contributions to the literature in Advanced Body Imaging are eligible for Emeritus Fellowship in the Society.

### Procedures for Change in Status

Emeritus Fellowship is conferred by the Board of Directors on Fellows at the recommendation of the Fellow Nominating Committee.

### Rights and Duties

Emeritus Fellows shall be exempt from the payment of dues, beginning in the year in which the individual attains Emeritus Fellowship status. Emeritus Fellows shall have all the rights of Fellows including serving on standing and ad hoc committees except: (i) the right to vote, and (ii) the right to hold office.
